

Definitions (refresher)

- Capacity: The physical capital invested in the fishery.
 (number of vessels, engine power, investment funds, ...)
 => Tangible, concrete assets
- Effort: The use of the capacity in fisheries.
 (time spent, capacity utilization, idle, ...)
 => Measurable, more value added.
 - Nominal effort: Direct measure of time spent fishing per boat.
 - ▶ Effective effort: Adds non-tangible components (technology, knowledge).




Implications of increased effort: CPUE

Catch per Unit of Effort (1950 = 1)





Catch per Unit of Effort (1950 = 1)





